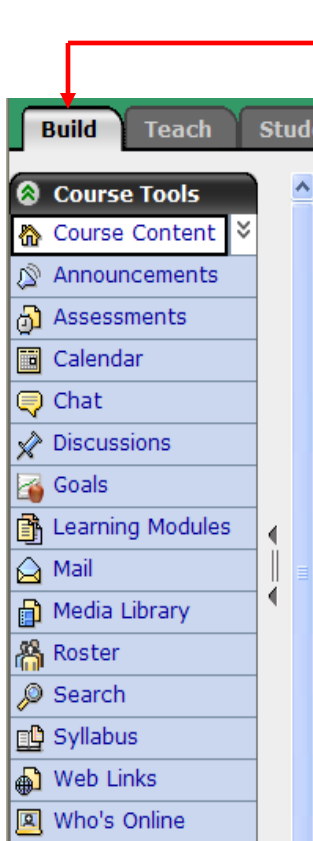


Tutorial de *Safe Assign*

Para crear un "Safe Assign" debes estar en el "tab" de **BUILD**



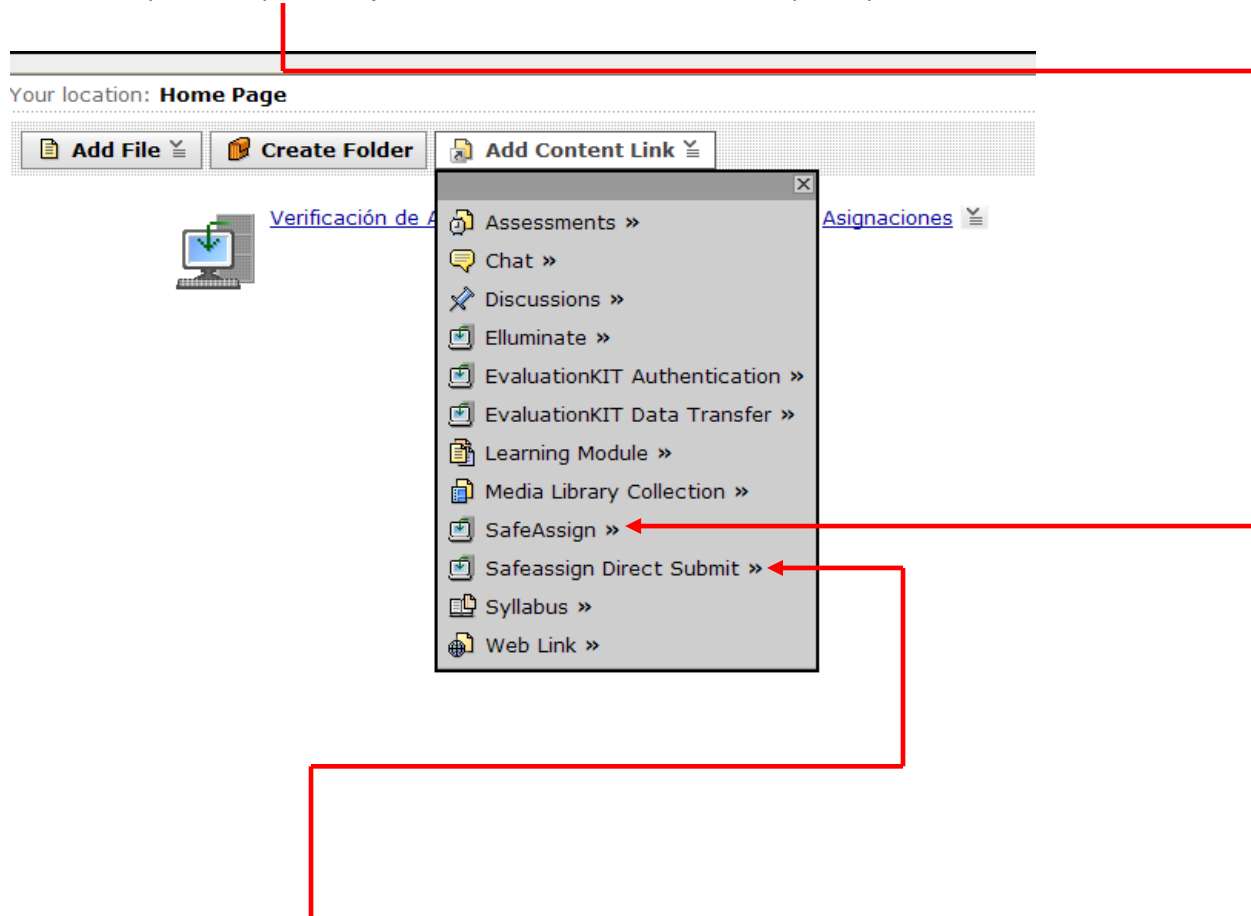
Luego oprima el botón: **Add Content Link**

Cuando estamos creando el “**Safe Assign**” debemos tener en cuenta cómo se va a utilizar el mismo, ya que nos permite crear dos tipos de Safe Assign.

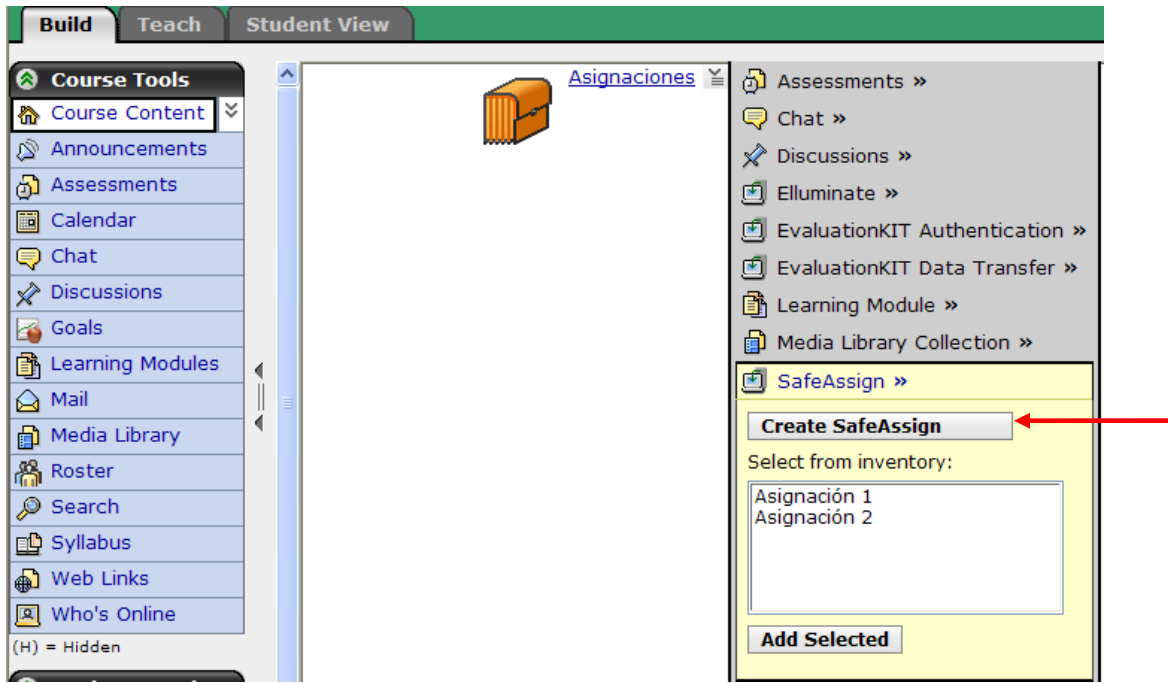
1. Crear un **Safe Assign** se utiliza en sustitución del buzón de asignaciones, con la particularidad es que no se puede adjuntar un documento dentro sino que hay que escribir dentro la mismas.



2. Crear un “**Safe Assign Direct Submit**” – se utiliza para la verificación de documento que son enviados por el buzón de asignaciones. Es decir, para verificar las asignaciones recibidas se debe adjuntar individualmente cada una de ellas.


Luego de crear el “**Safe Assign**” vamos a pasar al “tab” de **Teach** para crear el inventario de las asignaciones.



The issue of academic honesty and plagiarism are very relevant and important points in my workspaces. Currently I work as Blackboard administrator and part-time professor at a university. However in my experience as a teacher have been many occasions where students have committed plagiarism to perform its task so the had to criminalize these actions and continue to emphasize the current and future implications as professionals. In the technical area of the administration of the Blackboard platform turned to create codes block to avoid that students can copy, print or capture the information in order to sell or disclose it to others for their benefit which is a clear act of dishonesty and lack integrity. I am currently in the process of implementing the use of safe tool to assign teachers to provide the most advanced technological mechanism against these acts. The scholar-practitioner model has great value to me because I will extend my knowledge and critical thinking. This would help me with this in education to benefit my students yet to complete my Ph.D. I hope to focus on developing security strategies and controls to the new cyber technology and telecommunications.
